



# Small Business Recovery Fund

**Has Your Business Been Impaired by COVID -19?**



*The Harris County Small Business Recovery Fund program (SBRF) is a \$30 million grant program designed to assist small businesses operating in Harris County that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.*

*Eligible businesses can now obtain grants up to \$25,000 to support their ongoing operations and to help business owners stay afloat as Harris County continues to fight the coronavirus crisis. Funded through the federal CARES Act, the SBRF is not a loan program and does not have to be repaid. However, program funds are limited and only a subset of randomly selected applicants will receive grants through this program.*

## **What You Need to Know**

- For profit and non-profit businesses must have 30 or fewer employees
- Business must be located within Harris County to be eligible for the program. Businesses located within City of Houston are not eligible for the program unless they are located within Precinct One
- Business must have been in operation for the entire 2019 calendar year
- Gambling businesses, residential builders, speculative real estate investors, and sexually oriented businesses are not eligible
- Funds can be used for a wide range of business operation costs
- Funds will be disbursed in two (2) installments: 75% upon approval and 25% in November 2020
- Business must show proof that it is still in business in order to receive the final 25% grant installment

## **To Apply**

- Business tax return for 2018 or 2019
- Income and expenses for 3 months
- Articles of incorporation, business license, or DBA certificate
- W-2 statement, pay stubs, or personal tax return

- Program opens for applications on July 13, 2020 at 8am thru July 24, 2020 at 3:30pm
