Virtual Public Meeting
US 90 from I-10 to FM 1463
CSJs 0271-09-025, 0271-09-026, & 0271-10-011 (CC)
Waller, Fort Bend, and Harris Counties, Texas

Given the unique circumstance of the COVID-19 outbreak, along with our commitment to protecting public health during this national emergency, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Houston District is conducting this virtual public meeting to avoid in-person contact.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen United States Highway (US) 90 from Interstate Highway 10 (I-10) to Farm-to-Market (FM) 1463 in Waller, Fort Bend and Harris counties, Texas. The virtual public meeting will be available on the TxDOT website beginning Tuesday, July 28, 2020, at 5:30 P.M. through 11:59 P.M. on Wednesday, August 12, 2020. To log onto the meeting, go to www.txdot.gov, keyword search US 90 from I-10. The virtual meeting will consist of a narrated presentation by the project team, project exhibits and other information, and an opportunity to comment. If you do not have internet access, you may call (713) 802-5358 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail, online, or email, as explained below.

The purpose of the public meeting is to present the proposed project to the public and receive comments. The proposed design would widen the existing US 90 from a two-lane roadway to a four-lane roadway with a raised median. Within the City of Brookshire, the improvements will add a center left-turn lane to the existing four-lane roadway. Sidewalks, shared-use paths and/or bikeways are proposed on both sides of the roadway.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps, and drawings showing the project location and design; tentative construction schedules; and other information regarding the proposed project are available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search US 90 from I-10.

TxDOT makes every reasonable effort to accommodate the needs of the public. The virtual public meeting materials and exhibits will be in English. The narrated project presentation will be in English and Spanish. If you have a special communication accommodation or need for an interpreter, a request can be made. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can also be made to accommodate most needs. Please reference CSJ 0271-09-025 (CC) on all comments. All comments must be received by Wednesday, August 12, 2020. Responses to comments received will be available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search US 90 from I-10 approximately three months after the comment period closes.
